In the UK, VEKA Recycling was the very first in the industry to establish a closed-loop recycling facility of this kind.

In 2018, The VEKA Recycling Group recycled in excess of 75,000 tonnes of old UPVC windows and doors. This is the equivalent of over 4.5 million windows per annum.

The VEKA Recycling Group has made a multi-million-pound investment in a new state of the art recycling facility in Wellingborough, Northamptonshire for the continued processing of old UPVC windows.

VEKA Recycling is committed to creating a cost-effective and sustainable alternative to landfill across the UK. Our primary processing facility in the UK accepts post-consumer frames and post-industrial offcuts of any brand of windows.



THE VEKA RECYCLING GROUP WHERE ARE WE?

There are three plants within the VEKA Recycling Group:

VEKA Recycling Wellingborough UK VEKA UT Behringen Germany VEKA Recyclage Vendeuvre-sur-Barse France

VEKA UT in Germany has been operating Europe's most advanced UPVC recycling plant in the town of Behringen for over 25 years.

VEKA Recyclage in France has established a similar facility to VEKA Recycling's UK operation. Situated in Vendeuvre-sur-Barse, it collates material from France, Spain and Portugal for processing in Germany.

The VEKA Recycling Group recycles over 75,000 tonnes of UPVC windows per year which is in excess of 4.5 million windows annually – all to a level of purity that can be made directly into new windows.

WHY RECYCLE **OLD WINDOWS**

The average window manufacturer and installer disposes of 30-40 UPVC frames per week which is an average of almost two tonnes per month. The average price for a skip holding this tonnage is in excess of £350. Using this estimate, if you exchange one skip per month you could have an annual cost of over £4.000.

VEKA Recycling offers a sustainable method of saving you money. We successfully collect thousands of tonnes across the UK reducing your skip costs and landfill charges.

WHAT IS LANDFILL TAX?

Landfill Tax was introduced as an effective measure in deterring landfilling of waste material and encouraging behaviour change. Since its introduction the rate of tax has increased steadily and substantially (approximately £5.00 - £6.00 per tonne each year). The rates are increased with the specific intention of incentivising recycling waste materials and reducing the level of landfill.

DID YOU KNOW...

Every UPVC window can be recycled up to ten times with potentially 150 years of good UPVC recycled materials to be used.
